The labor to start a new work in the village of Naranjal is progressing slowly but steadily. Currently, Bible studies are being held Saturday mornings, with mostly children in attendance. The goal is to begin meetings on Sundays in the next month or two. Praise the Lord that one man accepted Christ as his Savior this last Saturday!

We trust that you had a wonderful celebration of our Lord's Resurrection this last Sunday. We certainly did here in San Ramon!

The last few weeks, we have been working a lot at the church here in San Ramon towards the evangelistic outreaches we were able to have this last week.

We began our first outreach on Saturday, the 19th. We showed an evangelistic film in the village of Naranjal, and from the first outreach, the enemy was not

happy. Despite multiple delays, including being forgotten by our hired transportation to the village, we were able to project the film that same night.



For Wednesday, the Christian school had set up a guided tour through the final days of Christ's life, with a very clear and solid presentation of Gospel and of the power of the Resurrection over sin and death. I was able to be the "tour guide" for several of the groups of parents that came. This was a very impactful and creative way of presenting the Gospel. Many of the parents that attended showed an increased interest in the Gospel message.

Thursday and Friday we held different open air outreaches with the church youth group. Through skits and preaching we were able to share the Gospel several times here in San Ramon. Saturday we showed another evangelistic film here in San Ramon, and Sunday we had special Resurrection Sunday services.



Though we were faced with obstacles at almost every event, the Lord provided the means to press on and proclaim the Good News. Many heard, and many are searching and asking good questions! Please pray for the people we have reached so far. Pastor Jorge and I had the privilege of seeing one gentleman accept Christ as his Savior Saturday morning in Naranjal! Another young lady was saved after the film that night in San Ramon! Praise the Lord for His mighty works! Please continue in great prayer for the ministry here over the next few weeks.
